To the inhabitants of Lier.

We are happy to say we can begin vaccinations against COVID-19 right away in 2021. This flyer provides information about how vaccinations will be conducted in our municipality.

Date/time for vaccinations

The first COVID-19 vaccines will reach our municipality the first week of January. The residents of our nursing homes will be the first to receive the vaccination. Prioritised groups will follow in turn, based on instructions from the Norwegian Institute of Public Health (FHI).

The Municipality of Lier will then receive a new shipment of vaccines each week. FHI will decide how many doses of vaccines are sent to our municipalities each week. Instructions issued by FHI and the number of vaccines that are available in Norway will determine who is prioritised at any given time.

You will be contacted

The Municipality of Lier needs to compile a list over the people who wish to receive the vaccine so we can contact you when it is your turn. We will therefore create a waiting list on which you can register your interest in vaccination.

You will be contacted by SMS or conventional mail when you can join the waiting list. You do not need to do anything until you receive further information.

Practical information

The COVID-19 vaccination is voluntary and free.

However, you do need to decide whether you wish to receive the vaccine or not.
